The second day of the Trial Advocacy Seminar will be an actual trial of an OVI case that was previously tried at a municipal court in Lorain County. The trial will feature:

The Honorable Thomas Teodosio as the presiding judge

JD Tomlinson, Lorain County Prosecutor, for the prosecution

The Honorable D. Chris Cook for the defense

The jury will consist of those attending (you).

This will be an interactive session. The trial will begin with evidentiary issues and motions *in limine*, move to *voire dire*, opening statements, direct and cross examinations, and finish with closing arguments and jury instructions. The jury (you) will the deliberate and issue its verdict. There will be moderated breaks between sections to discuss the why's and how's of what just occurred.

\*These seminars satisfy the requirements of the Ohio Public Defender's Office for appointed counsel to qualify for state reimbursement. Day One satisfies criminal law hours and Day Two satisfies OVI hours.
